How do I apply?

Fill out the attached grant application and e-mail it back to Susan at susang@slavicvillage.org or drop it off at University Settlement at 4800 Broadway Avenue. Deadline is Friday, April 10.

Who is eligible for a mini grant?

Any Slavic Village resident.

What is the timeline?

Applications are due back by April 10, 2020. Money must be spent within 1 month. A final report will be due within 15 days of completion.

Who makes the funding decision ?

There will be a 4-person panel which will review the applications based on the following criteria: Connectivity, creativity, practicality and safety.

What type of activities and projects can this grant fund?

Basically anything that makes people feel less isolated during mandated social distancing.
Get creative.

How much is the grant?

The maximum amount for a mini grant is \$250, \$200 of which can be spent on supplies and \$50 of which can be allocated for your time.

Reporting requirement ?

Each grantee recipient will be required to sign documentation about the grant funding , and submit a 1 page final report.
